

**Minutes of Pike Road Town Council Regular Meeting  
Tuesday, October 15, 2024|6:00 PM  
Pike Road Town Hall**

Mayor Stone called the meeting to order at 6:00 PM. Councilman Fuhrman opened the meeting in prayer. Mayor Stone led the Pledge of Allegiance.

Roll Call: Council members present were Angie Bradsher, Chris Dunn, Doug Fuhrman, and Chris Myers. A quorum was noted. Rob Steindorff was absent.

Consideration was given to the minutes for the regular meeting on September 25, 2024. Councilman Fuhrman made a motion to accept the minutes as presented, Councilman Myers seconded. Unanimous consent was given. The minutes were accepted as presented.

### Reports

#### Planning

Chairperson of the Planning Commission, Chris Dunn, reported that the Planning Commission had three items on their agenda last week. A Conditional Use Permit for Manufactured Home on Wilkinson Road was not approved, a Final Plat for Abbington, Plat 4 was approved, and the Development Plan for Baptist Health at the Merry Corners Development was tabled until the next meeting.

Senior Planner, Darrell Rigsby, noted that they are drafting the Comp Plan and would have a draft available soon.

#### Other Business

Mayor Stone noted that he had received a renewal for our Solid Waste Removal Contract for a 3-year extension with no increases and would be signing and sending back.

There was some discussion of a communication plan with the School Board to share an update on the status of the High School Project. Katy Brasfield also shared that the playground equipment was on site and the installation should begin this week. A tentative grand opening is scheduled for our Founder's Day on October 24, 2025. Brasfield noted that she would share details once they were finalized. There was also much discussion about the upcoming Plein Air Paint Out beginning on Thursday, October 17, 2024, through Saturday, October 19, 2024.


