

**Minutes of Pike Road Town Council Regular Meeting  
Wednesday, May 22, 2024|7:00 AM  
Pike Road Town Hall**

Mayor Stone called the meeting to order at 7:02 AM. Councilman Fuhrman opened the meeting with prayer. Mayor Stone led the Pledge of Allegiance.

Roll Call: Council members present were Angie Bradsher, Chris Dunn, Doug Fuhrman, Chris Myers, and Rob Steindorff. A quorum was noted.

Consideration was given to the minutes for the regular council meeting on May 13, 2024. Councilman Fuhrman made a motion to accept the minutes as presented. Councilman Steindorff seconded. Unanimous consent was given. The minutes were accepted as presented.

Mayor Stone, on behalf of him and the town council, presented a Proclamation to Tommy Ratliff for his service on the Pike Road Board of Education since its inception. All council members had comments of praise for him and his dedication to the school board and the town. Superintendent Lankford was also in attendance and praised Ratliff.

#### Old Business
