Al Tennant Slater was born in Salt Lake City, Utah on October 9, 1917. He was a World War II Army Veteran who served in the Rhineland Campaign, European Theatre. He was in England, France, and Germany.

After the war, Al came home to his wife and his oldest child (whom he had never seen... the baby was born right after he left for the war).

When he returned home, he brought his wife a bracelet of British coins he had collected while serving in England. (Years later, when his wife died, he gave this bracelet to a granddaughter who along with her daughter cherishes it today.
