

**Minutes of Pike Road Town Council Regular Meeting
Monday, September 9, 2024|6:00 PM
Pike Road Town Hall**

Mayor Stone called the meeting to order at 5:59 PM. Councilman Steindorff opened the meeting in prayer. Mayor Stone led the Pledge of Allegiance.

Roll Call: Council members present were Chris Dunn, Doug Fuhrman, Chris Myers, and Rob Steindorff. A quorum was noted. Angie Bradsher was absent.


