# Minutes of Pike Road Town Council Regular Meeting Monday, September 9, 2024|6:00 PM Pike Road Town Hall

Mayor Stone called the meeting to order at 5:59 PM. Councilman Steindorff opened the meeting in prayer. Mayor Stone led the Pledge of Allegiance.
