

**Minutes of Pike Road Town Council Regular Meeting
Monday, June 9, 2025|6:00 PM
Pike Road Town Hall**

Mayor Stone opened the Public Hearing at 6:06 PM. The Public Hearing advertised was for zoning ordinance text amendments. Planning Director, Keith Covington gave an overview to the council. There were no public comments. There was some discussion by the council. Mayor Stone closed the public hearing at 6:18 PM.
