

**Minutes of the Pike Road Town Council
Special Called Meeting
Tuesday, September 2, 2025
Pike Road Town Hall
12:00 Noon**

Section 11-46-55, Code of Alabama- The governing body shall meet on the first Tuesday following the Municipal Election to canvass the returns

Mayor Stone called the meeting to order at 12:00 p.m. Councilman Chris Dunn opened the meeting with prayer. Mayor Stone led the group in the pledge of allegiance.

A quorum was noted with Mayor Stone, Councilman Dunn, Councilman Steindorff, Councilwoman Bradsher and Councilman Fuhrman present.

Councilwoman Bradsher made a motion to suspend the reading of the minutes. Councilman Fuhrman seconded. The reading of the minutes was suspended by unanimous vote.

Business at hand

Mayor Stone recognized Brenda Daly, W. Mark Anderson and Barbara Jenkins of the Montgomery County Board of Registrars and Alexandria Stephens and Marjorie Smith of the Montgomery Election Center for the review of provisional ballots cast in the August 26, 2025, Municipal Election. Ms. Daly presented the report from the Board of Registrars submitting the list of verified provisional voters. Ms. Daly noted that fourteen provisional ballot statements were presented to the BOR on August 27, 2025, and after careful evaluation four were deemed eligible to be counted. (Report attached) Alexandria Stephens then proceeded to open the provisional sealed box of ballots and pull the names of those voters that were eligible to be counted. She then passed the said provisional ballot envelopes to Marjorie Smith of the Montgomery Election Center to open the provisional ballot envelopes and secrecy envelopes and the ballots before counting. The public counting of four provisional ballots was held, and totals were tallied, and results were read, and the winners of the races were declared. Mark Spurlin 3 and Gordon Stone 1 provisional votes added to the preliminary numbers. Total votes counted are Mark Spurlin 1515 and Gordon Stone 1567. Chris Dunn 0 and Mim Whatley 4 provisional votes added to the preliminary numbers. Total votes counted are Chris Dunn 1329 and Mim Whatley 1627 for Place 1. William "Bill" Cornwell 1, Jeffrey Lewis 1 and Marcus Robinson 2 provisional votes added to the preliminary numbers. Total votes counted are William "Bill" Cornwell 1157, Jeffrey Lewis 174, and Marcus Robinson 1614 for Place 3. Doug Fuhrman 3 and Blake Ioimo 1 provisional votes added to the preliminary numbers. Total votes counted are Doug Fuhrman 1992 and Blake Ioimo 795 for Place 5.

Resolution 020-2025 to Canvass Election Results-Municipal Election August 26,2025 was presented for consideration to canvass the election results of the August 26, 2025, Municipal Election. Councilwoman Bradsher made a motion to approve **Resolution 020-2025 to Canvass Election Results-Municipal Election August 26,2025**. Councilman Steindorff seconded. Unanimous consent was given. The resolution was approved. (**Resolution 020-2025**)

Councilman Steindorff made a motion to issue a Certificate of Election for Mayor. Councilman Fuhrman seconded. A unanimous vote was taken. A Certificate of Election was issued to Gordon Stone for Mayor as the official canvass of votes cast show that in the August 26, 2025, Municipal Election the above named was duly elected to the said office.

Councilman Fuhrman made a motion to issue a Certificate of Election for Place 1. Councilman Steindorff seconded. A unanimous vote was taken. A Certificate of Election was issued to Mim Whatley for Councilmember Place 1 as the official canvass of votes cast show that in the August 26, 2025, Municipal Election the above named was duly elected to the said office.

Councilman Fuhrman made a motion to issue a Certificate of Election for Place 3. Councilwoman Bradsher seconded. A unanimous vote was taken. A Certificate of Election was issued to Marcus Robinson for Councilmember Place 3 as the official canvass of votes cast show that in the August 26, 2025, Municipal Election the above named was duly elected to the said office.

Councilwoman Bradsher made a motion to issue a Certificate of Election for Place 5. Councilman Steindorff seconded. A unanimous vote was taken. A Certificate of Election was issued to Doug Fuhrman for Councilmember Place 5 as the official canvass of votes cast show that in the August 26, 2025, Municipal Election the above named was duly elected to the said office.


With no further business the meeting was adjourned with a motion from Councilwoman Bradsher, seconded by Councilman Fuhrman at 12:18 p.m.
