

Minutes of Pike Road Town Council Regular Meeting Monday, July 13, 2026|6:00 PM

Mayor Stone called the meeting to order at 6:00 PM. Councilman Steindorff opened the meeting in prayer. Mayor Stone led the Pledge of Allegiance.

Roll Call: Council members present were Angie Bradsher, Doug Fuhrman, Rob Steindorff, Marcus Robinson, and Mim Whatley. A quorum was noted.

Consideration was given to the minutes for the regular meeting on June 24, 2026. Councilman Fuhrman made a motion to accept the minutes as presented. Councilman Robinson seconded. Unanimous consent was given. The minutes were accepted as presented.

Reports

Planning

Planning Commission Chairman, Doug Fuhrman, reported that the Planning Commission had only one item on their agenda last week which was a subdivision of nineteen acres into three estate lots. It was approved.

Senior Planner, Darrell Rigsby, was not in attendance.

Old Business

The first item of old business was **Ordinance 2026-0620 Annexation of 2678 Pine Acres Road**. Councilman Fuhrman made a motion to approve **Ordinance 2026-0620 Annexation of 2678 Pine Acres Road**. Councilwoman Whatley seconded. The vote was unanimous, without a vote by Mayor Stone. The ordinance was adopted. (**Ordinance 2026-0620 Annexation of 2678 Pine Acres Road**)

The next item of old business was **Ordinance 2026-0621 Annexation of 217 Buckhead Drive**. Councilman Robinson made a motion to approve **Ordinance 2026-0621 Annexation of 217 Buckhead Drive**. Councilman Steindorff seconded. The vote was unanimous, without a vote by Mayor Stone. The ordinance was adopted. (**Ordinance 2026-0621 Annexation of 217 Buckhead Drive**)

The last item of old business was **Ordinance 2026-0622 Increase Revenue Sourcing**. Councilman Steindorff made a motion to approve **Ordinance 2026-0622 Increase Revenue Sourcing**. Councilwoman Whatley seconded. Councilwoman Bradsher thanked Clint Graves for his help and wanted to reassure the citizens that they have full confidence in their decision on how to fund the needs of the Town. The vote was unanimous, without a vote by Mayor Stone. The ordinance was adopted. (**Ordinance 2026-0622 Increase Revenue Sourcing**)

New Business

The first item of new business was **Ordinance 2026-_____ Annexation of 574 Roark Trace**. This was considered the first reading of the ordinance, and it will be on the agenda at the next regularly scheduled meeting.

The next item of new business was **Ordinance 2026-_____ Annexation of 5800 Trotman Road**. This was considered the first reading of the ordinance, and it will be on the agenda at the next regularly scheduled meeting.

Another item of new business was **ABC Licensure-Wibenco Traders, LLC-9538 Vaughn Road-040 Retail Beer (On/Off Premises) and 060 Retail Wine (On/Off Premises)**. Councilwoman Bradsher asked if they intended to sell off premises. The owner noted that they did not. Councilwoman Bradsher made a motion to approve **ABC Licensure-Wibenco Traders, LLC-9538 Vaughn Road-040 Retail Beer (On/Off Premises) and 060 Retail Wine (On/Off Premises)** with On Premises only. Councilman Steindorff seconded. The vote was unanimous, without a vote by Mayor Stone. The license was approved with conditions.

The next item of new business was **ABC Licensure-Global Grill Network, LLC-12776 US Hwy 80 E-020 Restaurant Retail Liquor**. Councilwoman Bradsher made a motion to approve **ABC Licensure- Global Grill Network, LLC-12776 US Hwy 80 E -020 Restaurant Retail Liquor**. Councilwoman Whatley seconded. The vote was unanimous, without a vote by Mayor Stone. The license was approved.

Another item of new business was **Resolution 025-2026-CDBG Grant Application**. Councilwoman Bradsher made a motion to approve **Resolution 025-2026-CDBG Grant Application** for a Senior Center. Councilman Fuhrman seconded. The vote was unanimous without a vote by Mayor Stone. The resolution was approved. (**Resolution-025-2026**)

The last item of new business was **Resolution 026-2026-ALDOT-Agreement-Tap Grant-Wallahatchie Road Phase III-TAPMN-TA16(949)**. Mayor Stone noted that this had already been approved before Covid, but ALDOT was requesting re-approval to move forward. Councilman Steindorff made a motion to accept **Resolution 026-2026-ALDOT-Agreement-Tap Grant-Wallahatchie Road Phase III-TAPMN-TA16(949)**. Councilman Robinson seconded. The vote was unanimous, without a vote by Mayor Stone. The resolution was approved. (**Resolution 026-2026-ALDOT-Agreement-Tap Grant-Wallahatchie Road Phase III-TAPMN-TA16(949)**)

Other Business

Councilwoman Bradsher made a request to use Discretionary Funds for Spirit Jerseys for the faculty at Pike Road High School of up to \$2000. Councilman Steindorff seconded. The expenditure was approved with a unanimous vote, without a vote by Mayor Stone. There was also discussion about another request that had not been reviewed by the superintendent's office, so it would be addressed at a later date.

With no further business at hand, Councilman Fuhrman made a motion to adjourn at 6:31 PM. Councilman Steindorff seconded the motion. Unanimous consent was given. The meeting was adjourned.
