

Pike Road Planning Commission Meeting

1. Case No.: SDP 26.10 Pike Road Arts District Plat No.1

Description: Preliminary Plat request to plat 9.03 +/- acres into 1 lot for institutional and recreational purposes.

Location: South side of Wallahatchie Road, approximately 1.0 miles east of the intersection of Pike Road and Wallahatchie Road.

Applicant: Town of Pike Road.
